

20. Walk & Trot Equitation 18 & over – for riders who have not started cantering.

24. Flat shod Pleasure Ponies – Walk & Trot lesson ponies.

27. Beginning Showmanship – for walk and trot riders only.
28. Walk & Trot Equitation 6 & under – without a lead.

Virginia Winter Tournament cont.

- * Entry fees are \$10 per class, stalls are \$20 each. Riders cannot cross enter between divisions. ENTRIES ARE DUE NO LATER THAN 12 PM on the WEDNESDAY BEFORE THE TOURNAMENT! LATE ENTRIES WILL BE CHARGED a \$5.00 LATE FEE.
- * Horses - Academy horses must be school horses regularly used in the lesson program. An owner may show his or her own horse in an academy class only if said horse is used in a lesson program.
- * Equipment - Horses must have an appropriate type saddle, but may use any type of bridle. Hunt seat or western saddles are permitted. Protective equipment is optional. No braiding or hoof blacking.
- * Riders - No riding suits. Helmets are required, jods and jod boots recommended, but not required. Riders' age as of December 1 of tournament year will be the age group said rider will compete in throughout all tournaments. Once a rider has cantered, return to walk and trot classes is prohibited. Riders cannot show walk and trot only and walk, trot, and canter at the same show. Rider classification is the responsibility of the instructor. HOLDING A RIDER BACK IN A LOWER CLASS IF THAT RIDER IS READY TO ADVANCE IS DISCOURAGED.
- * Advanced Classes - Open to all academy riders and show riders. Figure work may be called for.
- * Intermediate classes - For academy riders only. Light figure work may be called for.
- * Beginner - For academy riders only. Instructors may enter the ring with students if necessary.
- * Showmanship classes - Rider is judged on ability to follow instructions and to show their horse. Diagonals and leads are still important.
- * When entering riders in Intermediate and Beginner classes, please include an "A" for advanced or a "B" for beginner in case the classes have to be split.
- * UPHA class-Once a rider wins a UPHA class they are qualified for the championship, which will be at the last tournament in February and are not allowed to show in that class again until the last tournament. The championship class in February will consist of first and second place riders from the other three tournaments.
- * Classes may be divided when there are 6 or more riders.
- * Horses are not to be judged. All classes except pleasure are to be judged on the ability of the rider to control and show their horse to their best advantage in addition to correct equitation. Even though classes are not judged on equitation only, correct diagonals and leads are important.



Stallion Sweeps Frequently Asked Questions

Do online orders receive tickets?

Yes, the American Saddlebred Horse Association (ASHA) will send you tickets upon purchase in the mail.

Is it open for ASHA members only?

- You don't have to be an ASHA member but you do need to have an ASHA online account to buy a ticket(s). It is just 2 easy steps to create an online account.
 - 1- Fill out the form on this page and click on Submit:
<https://www.asha.net/BecomeAMember/Register/>
 - 2- Create your username and password, Submit the form, and follow the link to purchase your tickets for the Stallion Sweeps

How does the drawing work?

- Each of the 15 American Saddlebred stallions in the sweepstakes is designated a number, when filling out your raffle ticket or the online form, please designate which stallion you would like to purchase ticket(s) for. The drawings for each stallion will be held in the ASHA Office, Lexington, KY on Friday, January 18th, 2019. You do not need to be present to win.

Which breeding season will the stallion services be eligible for?

- The stallion services may be used for the 2019 or 2020 breeding seasons.

Does the winner of each stallion have return privileges?

- The winner of the breeding service will be required to sign the service contract of that individual stallion. Each stallion may have differing offerings as it pertains to return privileges, etc. Collections and shipping charges are not included, and the winner will have no right to transfer, sell, or assign the breeding service, etc.

Where is the money raised from the Stallion Sweeps program going?

- All proceeds from the Stallion Sweeps program will be used for the promotion of breeding the American Saddlebred.

For the past several years, the Virginia Horse Industry Board (VHIB) has approved additional money to the American Saddlebred Horse Association of Virginia (ASHAV) futurities through its “Virginia Bred” Grant program. We are extremely appreciative of the VHIB for the help they are giving the Virginia American Saddlebred community.


